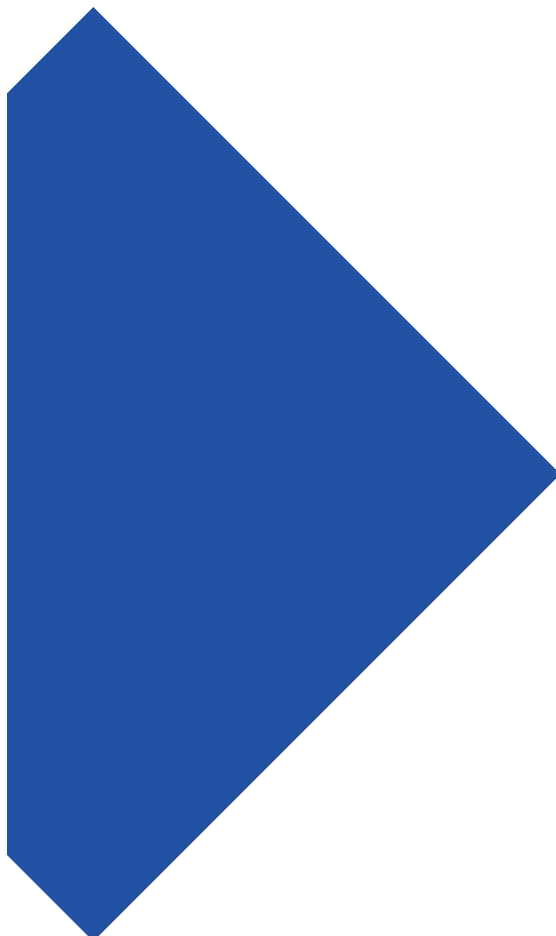

## The aim

Sustainability keeps gaining popularity as we search for balance between various social, economic, and environmental goals. There's a growing demand for professionals who can develop, assess and implement sustainable solutions, policies, and standards both in the public and private sector. The competencies required by the job market are evolving in favour of transdisciplinary communication and data-driven decisions. BASUS answers this demand by providing future-ready, interdisciplinary education, focused on research and soft skills, fully aligned with the European GreenComp Framework.

## General information

The Una Europa Joint Bachelor in Sustainability (BASUS) is a three-year interdisciplinary undergraduate programme, organised and developed by eight leading European universities within the Una Europa alliance.

The degree will be awarded by six universities: Helsingin yliopisto/ Helsingfors universitet, Uniwersytet Jagielloński w Krakowie, KU Leuven, Universidad Complutense de Madrid, Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, and Universität Zürich.

## Programme structure

All students spend the first two semesters in Kraków, following an interdisciplinary curriculum co-taught by academic teachers from Una Europa universities.

Then, for the following three semesters, each student studies one of the six thematic tracks, hosted by different universities and taught by an international group of teachers. The final semester allows for mobility – students will choose one of the eight partner universities.

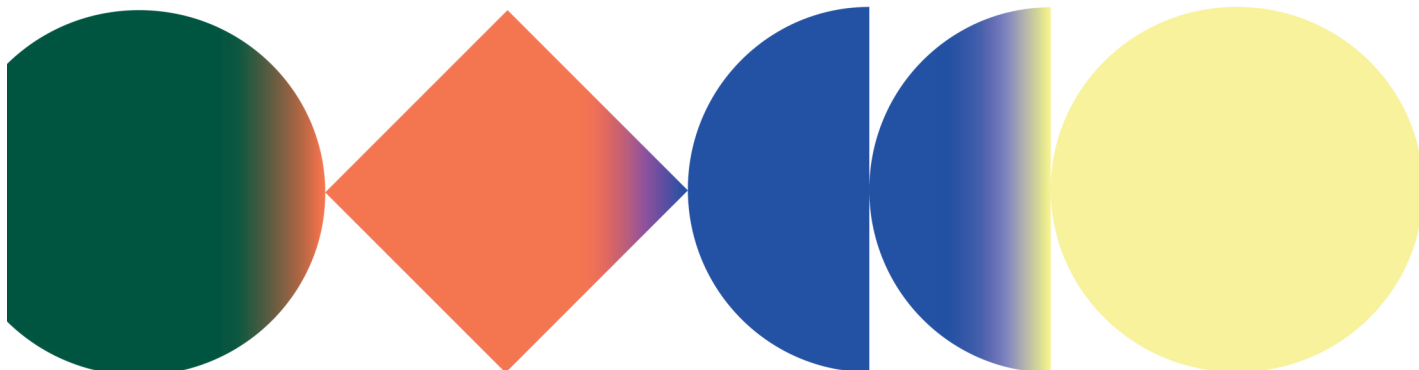
